

# Tokyo Metropolitan Kokusai High School

## Essential Points of Application for Admission in September 2026 for Foreign Students Living in Tokyo

### 1 Application

10 Japanese students returning to Japan and foreign students living in Tokyo will be admitted in September.

### 2 Qualifications

The applicant must

- be born before April 2, 2011.
- live in Tokyo with \*guardian (s) and not be enrolled at any high school or college at the time of making application to this school.
- continue to reside in and commute from an address inside Tokyo after admission to this school.
- satisfy each of the following requirements.

\*Guardians are those who exercise parental authority over an applicant; therefore, basically, his or her parents.

\*In case the applicant isn't able to live with both parents, he/she is allowed to live with one of them if certified.

- (a) The applicant must complete a 9-year course of school education abroad within the period from April 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026.
- (b) The applicant must complete a 9-year course at an educational facility for foreign residents in Japan, which is equivalent to a 9-year course of Japanese compulsory education within the period from April 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026.

\*Those who applied for the entrance exam below are not eligible to apply:  
the exam for admission in April 2026 either students returning to Japan or  
foreign students living in Tokyo.

### 3 Application Submission

(a) Time

Wednesday, July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Thursday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon

(b) Place

Tokyo Metropolitan Kokusai High School

(The application should be delivered to the school office by hand.)

(c) Required Form and Procedures

(1) The official Application Form (「様式国際在京 2」)

(2) The certificate of the academic record of the applicant's last school year

This (These) document (s) should be certified original (s) kept in a sealed envelope.

(This (These) document (s) must contain a certification that the applicant has satisfactorily completed a 9-year course of school education.)

(3) If the applicant has a foreign nationality, submit “Juminhyo kisaijiko shomeisho (様式応 3)” of the applicant and the parent(s) issued after April 1, 2026, by a municipal office in the applicant's residential area, or the equivalent.

(4) “Riyusho” (様式応 7)

If one of the parents will not be able to live with the applicant in Tokyo, submit “Riyusho” (The statement of the reason) with some documents to certify the reason.

(5) Entrance Examination Fee

Applicants are required to pay ¥2,200 ( exact fee, only by cash ) to the school office when submitting the application. The fee will not be returned.

(6) The applicant's Personal History

Please refer to the example supplied.

(7) “Kikokutounikansuru Moushitatesho (様式応 5)”

Applicants who are living overseas and will move to Tokyo with their parents are required to submit this form.

(8) An extra form is required from applicants who

- live outside Tokyo in Japan now, but are certain to be living in Tokyo by the date of the entrance ceremony.

- live in Tokyo but attend a school outside of Tokyo.

Please ask for these forms at the school office.

Essay and interview, either in Japanese or in English

## 6 Entrance Formalities

Successful applicants are expected to complete the “School Entrance Agreement Form” within the period stated below in order to complete the entrance formalities :

9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026

9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Tuesday, July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2026

at the school office

Those who have not completed the entrance formalities within the above-mentioned period will be regarded as having withdrawn their application.

The School Entrance Agreement Form is invalid unless the School Entrance Fee of ¥5,650 is paid. The payment deadline is specified in the letter of acceptance (Goukaku-tsuchisho).

## 7 Others

- (a) Applicants who do not comply with the Application Qualifications, or have failed to complete and present all the necessary forms, or have given false statements, will be disqualified even after they have been accepted.
- (b) Successful students of IBDP will not be eligible for September admission to other Metropolitan high schools, including this school.
- (c) All classes at Kokusai High School are taught in Japanese except for foreign language classes.
