(Pause: 5 sec.)

N: これからリスニングテストを行います。放送の指示に従って答えなさい。放送中に メモをとってもかまいません。では始めます。

N: 1番。これから2つの対話が放送され、それぞれの対話の後に、質問が1つあります。 質問に対する答えとして、最も適切なものをア~エの中から1つ選び、記号で答えな さい。対話と質問は1度だけ読まれます。解答時間はそれぞれ8秒です。

M: Number 1

(Pause: 1.5 sec.)

F: Hello, Ryan. I'm almost at Kokusai Station.

M: Hi, Jane. I called you because I'll be late. I'm sorry.

F: What? We were going to meet at 9:30. Why are you late?

M: Well, I missed the train at 8:45, but I'll get on the train at 9:10. It takes 45 minutes from my station to Kokusai Station.

F: What time did you get up?

M: I was going to wake up at 7, but it was 8:10 when I got up. I was studying and reading until late at night.

F: You should not stay up so late before a special day like today.

M: You're right. Ah, my train is coming, so I'll see you later.

F: OK. See you later.

- M: That's right. I've already bought something for her. The T-shirt is actually a present for you. I knew you wanted some new T-shirts.
- F: How nice! Thank you, Chris. Don't return it.
- M: I'm glad you like it.

F: Question 1: What was wrong with the gift?

F: Question 2: What will Chris do with the gift?

(Pause: 8 sec.)

F: Hello, Kyle. I'm looking at volunteer programs in our city newspaper.

M: I can see there're many volunteer groups in our city. Why are you interested in volunteer work?

F: I did some volunteer work for the first time last month. I taught English to elementary school students. It was really fun, so I want to do volunteer work again. The children's smiles made me so happy.
