N: これからリスニングテストを行います。放送の指示に従って答えなさい。放送中に メモをとってもかまいません。では始めます。

N: 1番。これから2つの対話が放送され、それぞれの対話のあとに、質問が1つあります。質問に対する答えとして、最も適切なものをア~エの中から1つ選び、記号で答えなさい。対話と質問は1度だけ読まれます。解答時間はそれぞれ8秒です。

M: Number 1

(Pause: 1.5 sec.)

- F: Hi, Bob. I want you to help me with my homework.
- M: Hi, Akane. Of course.
- F: Thank you. I'm writing a report.
- M: What is it about?
- F: It's about things that foreign people are surprised at in Japan.
- M: That sounds interesting! Oh..., it's difficult to choose only one. Well..., I was especially surprised at vending machines.
- F: Vending machines?
- M: Yes. My friend Mike was also surprised at them.
- F: Really? Do you have the same reason?
- M: No, we have different reasons. I was surprised because they are found on almost every corner in Japan. When I climbed the highest mountain, I was able to buy drinks from the vending machines even near the top!
- F: Wow! I didn't know that! So, what's his reason?

- M: That's great! Was it a big party?
- F: No, it wasn't, but it was a long party. It started around noon and finished at five.
- M: It sounds like a wonderful time. But, you look so tired.
- F: Yes, I am. We came back late last night.
- M: What time did you arrive home?
- F: It was 11:30 p.m. The traffic was really terrible.
- M: That's too bad.
- F: It usually takes three hours by car, but it took three more hours last night.
- M: Wow..., that was a long time.

F: Question: What time did Cathy's family leave their grandparents' house?

N: 2番。これから2つの対話が放送され、それぞれの対話のあとに、質問が2つずつあります。質問に対する答えとして、最も適切なものをア〜エの中から1つ選び、記号で答えなさい。対話と質問は1度だけ読まれます。解答時間はそれぞれ8秒です。これからAの対話を放送します。

- F: Dad, I'm home!
- M: Hi, Kate. What do you have in your hand?
- F: This paper? I got it in front of the station. It's about a new restaurant.
- M: Let's see.... I know this restaurant. I had lunch there last week.
- F: Really? How was it?
- M: Well..., it was OK.
- F: Just OK? Was the food bad?
- M: I had curry and rice, but it was too hot. I should try another dish next time.
- F: I like hot food! How about eating dinner there tonight?
- M: Oh, I've already cooked dinner. How about tomorrow?

- F: Oh no! Look at this. The restaurant is closed every Tuesday.
- M: I see. How about the next day?
- F: Well.... I have a piano lesson on that day.
- M: What time will you come back home after the lesson?
- F: It will be about 6 p.m.
- M: All right. Let's go to the restaurant after you come back.
- F: OK. Let's check with Mom when she comes back.

M: Question 1: Why did Kate want to go to the new restaurant?

M: Question 2: What day will Kate and her father go to the new restaurant this week?

N: これから B の対話を放送します。

(Pause: 1.5 sec.)

- M: Christine, can I talk to you now?
- F: Yes, of course, John.
- M: I interviewed the students in my English classes. My question was, "Why are you studying English?"
- F: Wow, I want to know their reasons. We have taught English as ALTs at this high school for a year, but I have never thought about this.
- M: Can you guess the most popular reason? I want you to guess before I show you this paper.
- F: Is it to enter university? In Japan many students take English tests to enter universities.
- M: That's close. That's the second reason.
- F: Hmm. Is it to travel to other countries?
- M: That's the third reason. That's about 13% of the students.
- F: It's difficult to guess the first reason. Please show me the answer.
- M: OK, here you are. 30.2% of them are studying English to get a good job.
- F: Hmm, the second reason is 29.5%. These two numbers are close. And, there are other reasons, too.
