講座概要 / Course description	Economics is a social science. That means it involves the study of society or people. In particular economics is the study of how individuals and societies allocate scarce resources to meet unlimited wants. In IB Economics students will study the theory of economics and apply that knowledge to real world problems. Problems such as climate change, poverty, inequality, lack of access to health care and education can all be approached from an economic perspective. Different perspectives on government policy will also be examined. In particular, the extent to which governments should intervene in the allocation of resources. International issues are increasingly important in economics and the IB course focus is on being internationally minded.
到達目標 / Course objectives	1. encourage the systematic and critical study of: human experience and behaviour; physical, economic and social environments; and the history and development of social and cultural institutions 2. develop in the student the capacity to identify, to analyse critically and to evaluate theories, concepts and arguments about the nature and activities of the individual and society 3. enable the student to collect, describe and analyse data used in studies of society, to test hypotheses, and to interpret complex data and source material 4. promote the appreciation of the way in which learning is relevant both to the culture in which the student lives, and to the culture of other societies 5. develop an awareness in the student that human attitudes and beliefs are widely diverse and that the study of society requires an appreciation of such diversity 6. enable the student to recognize that the content and methodologies of Economics are contestable and that its study requires the tolerance of uncertainty. 7. develop an understanding of microeconomic and macroeconomic theories and concepts and their real-world application 8. develop an appreciation of the impact on individuals and societies of economic interactions between nations 9. develop an awareness of development issues facing nations as they undergo the process of change.
