There are many ways to acquire new skills in life, especially from important experiences that left an impression in our memory. However, life experiences can be both good and bad but are equally significant for us to learn certain skills. For example, if I had a bad experience of not being able to speak well in a speech contest, I might need to reflect on how to improve my communication skills such as speaking clearly or not speeding up my speech due to nervousness.

The methods of getting new skills are varied. One way can be to learn from someone who is knowledgeable or an expert in the field such as subject teachers in school or masters in certain crafts or martial arts. For example, there are many levels in Judo and there are tests to pass in order to obtain a certain color belt. The basic techniques have to be built and practiced often in order to move to the next level of certification. Another way of learning a skill such as collaborative skills is done through working with other people by listening and sharing ideas. Sometimes to be good at a skill such as at drawing or playing an instrument or figure skating, I need daily practices and continue doing the same thing over and over without giving up.
